

## Advertisement For Bids

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the Engineering Department of the City of Des Moines, Washington, until 2:00 P.M., on the **25<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2010** in the Public Works Service Center, 2255 South 223<sup>rd</sup> Street, Des Moines, WA 98198, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for:

South 216<sup>th</sup> Street Sidewalk Project

Work contemplated to be performed under this contract is as follows:

- Construct curb, gutter, and sidewalks along both sides of S 216<sup>th</sup> Street between 11<sup>th</sup> Ave S and Marine View Drive South.
- Widen S 216<sup>th</sup> Street to allow for a continuous left turn lane and bike lanes.
- Construct new and upgrade existing curb ramps to comply with ADA and WSDOT standards.
- Construct structural earth walls.
- Construct storm drainage improvements including removal of parts of the existing system and installation of flow control facilities.
- Construct storm outfall improvements with HDPE piping.
- Construct driveways with hot mix asphalt.
- Install lane markers, signs, and other channelization.
- Adjust utilities to grade.
- Overhead utility conversion.
- New water main construction.
- Provide irrigation, landscaping, fencing, and property restoration.
- And all incidental items necessary to complete the Work as described in the Plans.

This on-line plan room provides Bidders with fully usable on-line documents; with the ability to: download, view, print, order full/partial plan sets from numerous reprographic sources, and a free on-line digitizer/take-off tool. It is recommended that Bidders "Register" in order to receive automatic e-mail notification of future addenda and to place themselves on the "Self-Registered Bidders List". Bidders that do not register will not be automatically notified of addenda and will need to periodically check the on-line plan room for addenda issued on this project. Bidders are not to contact the City of Des Moines or the Engineer to obtain bid documents.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, postal money order, or bid bond made payable to the City of Des Moines in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Bid bonds shall be in a form satisfactory to the City Attorney. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory the bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit will be forfeited to the City of Des Moines.

The City of Des Moines hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, creed, sex or national origin in consideration for an award.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities in the bidding and to make the award as deemed to be in the best interest of the City. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of thirty (30) days after the date set for the bid opening.

All schedules on the Bid Proposal must be completed, or the bid shall be considered non-responsive. Basis for award shall be total Base Bid, which includes Schedule A, Schedule B, Schedule C, Schedule D, and Schedule E, and Schedule F.

It is understood that the Contracting Agency reserves the right to remove from the Proposal and Work any or all of the following: Schedule B, Schedule C, Schedule D, and Schedule E; if such be to the advantage of the Contracting Agency.

The City of Des Moines in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, nondiscrimination in Federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contracts entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, creed, sex or natural origin in consideration for an award.

This project is financed through the Community Development Block Grant Program with funds obtained from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (CFDA 14.218) and American Reinvestment and Recovery Act (ARRA) (CDBG-R CFDA 14.253). The contract will be subject to regulations of the Departments of Labor and Housing and Urban Development.
